**MICHAEL WALLIS**, author of *Billy the Kid: The Endless Ride* (WW Norton, March, 2007) is a National Book Award and three-time Pulitzer Prize nominee. He also is host of the new PBS Series *American Roads* and the voice of the sheriff in the animated Pixar feature *Cars*.

**LAURENCE SHINE** is a Professor of Anglo-Irish Literature at Buffalo State College. He was narrator and co-writer of the documentary film *Following James Joyce: Dublin to Buffalo*, directed by Patrick Martin. He is also co-founder and host of Bloomsday Buffalo and founder of the Ulysses Reading Circle.

**PATRICK MARTIN** is a partner in the firm of Kennedy, Stoeckl and Martin, legal counsel of the Buffalo and Erie County Public Library, and a literary agent of the Mark Twain Foundation, NY City and the Bancroft Library, University of California, Berkeley. He is President of riverrun, Director of Cinegael Buffalo, and producer and director of films on Nelson Mandela and James Joyce.
